

Data Cable Connection Instructions (Type 4)

Connecting a data cable to your computer and phone is a very simple process, as it is simply a matter of plugging in the cable at both ends. Any complexities involved through the use of a data cable will arise when you start to use software, not when connecting the cable.

1. Check the connection pins are straight, springy and of equal length before removing the cable from the sealed packaging. If pressed down very lightly the pins should spring back into place. If not, contact us and do not open the sealed packaging.



2. Remove the back cover and battery from your phone, and then open the sim card holder, remove the sim card and remove the plastic sim card holder clip.



3. Remove all pieces of foam protection from the connection pins on the bottom of the cable connector, and (model dependent) from the battery holder on top of the cable connector.

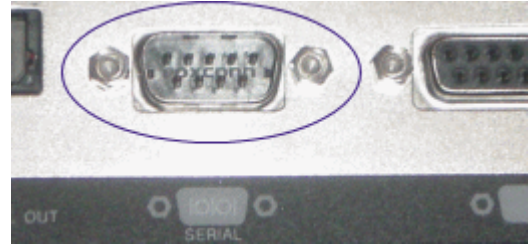
4. Insert the sim card into the sim card holder on the main connector, and then lock the sim card holder by pulling it shut.



5. Turn the connector around, and then insert your battery into the battery holder on the connector. Make sure the battery is fully charged before inserting it into the connector. Once both the sim card and battery are in place, check that they are inserted securely on the connector.
6. Insert the cable connector into the battery holder on your phone. The connector should fit securely and will have a locking mechanism to allow it to clip into place.



7. Locate the 9-pin RS-232 serial port on the back of your computer.



8. Insert the cable into the 9-pin RS-232 serial port and then lock the connector into place by turning the two thumb screws.



9. Turn on your mobile phone.
10. Turn on your computer and then run the required software. Suitable software is recommended in the item description page on our web site.
11. Check all the software settings are correct, and read our software tips and trouble-shooting sheet if your software is causing you problems.
